- Info from the President Mary Cailey

  - Mary noticed that few women voted on the Charity nominations. Each member has a vote and women need to exercise their vote.
  - Mary presented a talk about Round-Abouts in light of a new one going in at Longhorn and McLane.
    - The pro's are that they are the safest uncontrolled intersection, there are no left turns, there are less right away conflicts, traffic is slowed down and traffic flow is increased
    - Rules of Round- Abouts
      - Approaching traffic must yield to traffic already in the Round-About (yield is clearly marked)
      - Never stop to let traffic in
      - Use your turn signal to notify your turn out of the Round-About.
      - In a multilane one, turn into your needed lane when entering. Move to the right lane for exits 1 or 2, left lane for exiting 2nd or 3rd street before you exit
      - If you miss your exit go around again
    - Dave Pattino explained about how to properly stop for crosswalks
      - Yellow crosswalks mean you must wait for pedestrians to completely exit the crosswalk before moving
      - White crosswalks mean you can move once the pedestrian has cleared your lane
