
PAGE 3 A lot of us out there are still running drum brakes on our rides. With the newer and improved brake linings that are available these days, brake fade associated with drum brakes is all but a thing of the past in normal use. If you are in the process of replacing those brake shoes, take a good look at the backing plates where the brake shoes ride. They are often grooved which can cause erratic brake application if the grooves are deep enough. A simple fix for mild to moderate groove wear can be

done with a 3" 180 grit disc using your air operated Die grinder. For deep worn grooves, I usually fill the grooves with JB weld or equivalent.

Then hit them with your grinder.

Don't forget a dab of Lubriplate #105 on those sanded spots. Simple solution to make your drum brake job complete. No history on those brakes? Popping for a brake return spring kit is always a good idea. Can you stop on a dime? John Cailey
