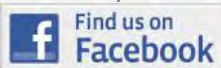


THE RIM COUNTRY CLASSIC AUTO CLUB IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF:

We are at around 146 participant registrations and 49 members and anticipate much more as we get closer to this event.

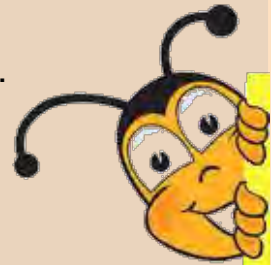

All Members- Stop by the Hospitality booth to see the beautiful baskets and purchase tickets for them as well as the 50/50 raffle.

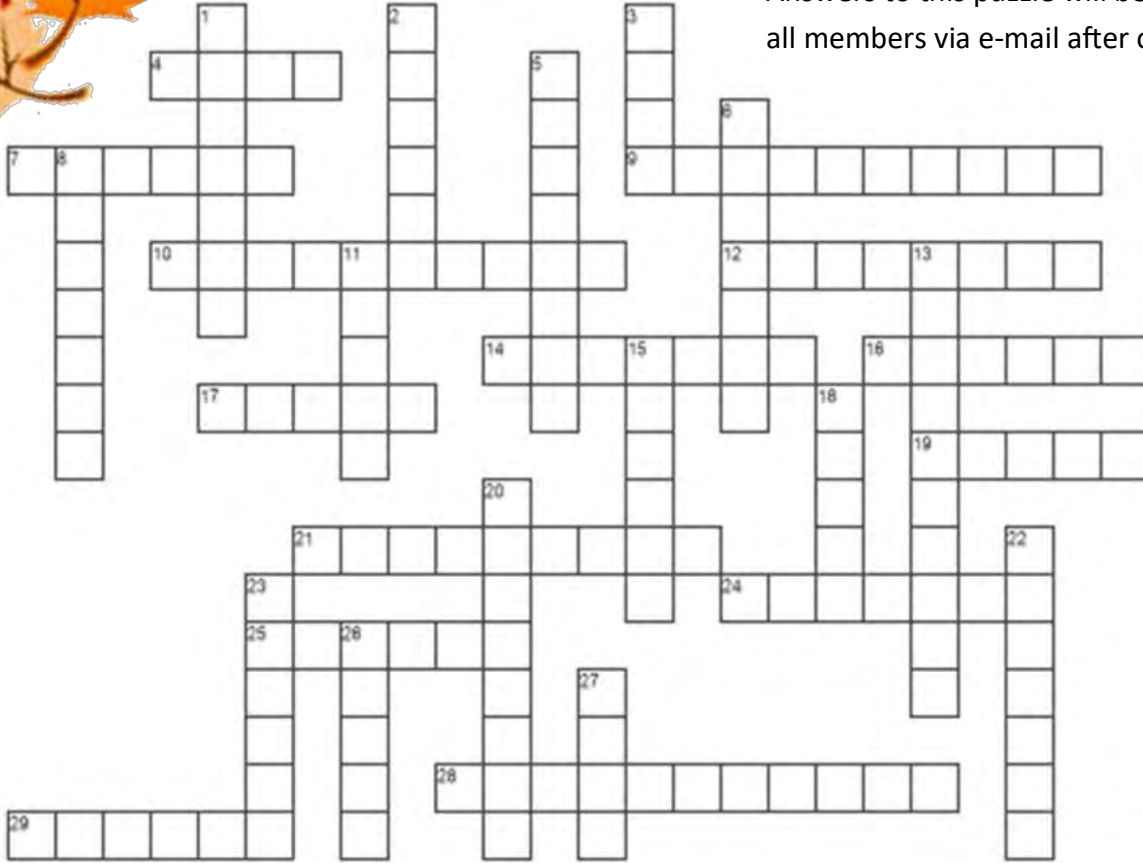
